I. Roll Call

B. HEARINGS

At 10:38 a.m. Ms. Hudson moved, Ms. Soberalski seconded, and the Board through individual roll call voted (4-0) to go into closed session to deliberate the Mark Harris matters.

After deliberating in closed session, Ms. Soberalski moved, Ms. Lueger seconded, and the Board voted (4-0) to come out of closed session at 11:46 a.m.

Ms. Hudson moved, Ms. Soberalski seconded, and the Board, by unanimous vote (4-0) found the evidence was not sufficient to sustain (HOC IA #14-008 for 5 days) violations of Civil Service Rule VII, Section 4(1), paragraphs (l) and (o), and dismissed the suspension.

Ms. Hudson moved, Ms. Soberalski seconded, and the Board, by unanimous vote (4-0) found the evidence was sufficient to sustain (HOC IA #14-009 for 10 days) violations of Civil Service Rule VII, Section 4(1), paragraphs (l) and (o), and reduced the suspension from 10 working days to 5 working days.

Ms. Hudson moved, Ms. Soberalski seconded, and the Board, by unanimous vote (4-0) found the evidence was sufficient to sustain (HOC IA #14-010 for 20 days) violations of Civil Service Rule VII, Section 4(1), paragraphs (l) and (o), and reduced the suspension from 20 working days to 10 working days.

Ms. Hudson moved, Ms. Soberalski seconded, and the Board, by unanimous vote (4-0) found the evidence was sufficient to sustain violations of Civil Service Rule VII, Section 4(1), paragraph(1) and HOC Rules 202.17, 202.19, 202.23, and 220.00 to wit 220.08.

Ms. Hudson moved, Ms. Soberalski seconded, and the Board, by vote (2-2) found the evidence was not sufficient to sustain (HOC IA #13-103) violations of Civil Service Rule VII, Section 4(1), paragraph (m).

Ms. Hudson moved, Ms. Soberalski seconded, and the Board, by unanimous vote (4-0) upheld the charge for discharge..

Ms. Hudson moved, Ms. Lueger seconded, and the Board, by vote of 4-0, adjourned the meeting at 11:47 AM.
