Mr. Delmenhorst moved, Mr. Karst seconded, and the Board voted (3-2; Mr. Doyle, Ms. Dukes dissenting) found the penalty of a 30-day suspension too severe and reduced the penalty to a 15-working-day suspension.

JANYCE ROCKETT, Clerical Assistant 2, Office of the Sheriff

Ms. Janyce Rockett failed to appear for her hearing after being served notice of the hearing date. Mr. Karst moved, Ms. Dukes seconded, and the Board by unanimous vote (5-0) found the evidence was sufficient and not controverted to sustain the charges, and upheld the 5-day suspension.
