



County Correctional Facility South Video Visiting Terms and Conditions

1. **Visitors must check in 15 minutes prior to scheduled visitation time.**
2. Visitation will be by appointment only; visits may be scheduled up to one week in advance by using the website.
3. Visits must be scheduled at least 24 hours in advance.
4. Each inmate is permitted to have up to 2 visitors per session, one session per week.
5. Visitors may schedule separate visits with multiple inmates.
6. Anyone causing a disturbance during visitation will have their visit ended. Anyone misusing the visitation equipment will have their visits canceled.
7. All visiting booths will be checked for damage after each visiting session. Visitors previously scheduled at the damaged booth will be charged with criminal damage to property. CCFS will seek restitution and your visiting privileges will be permanently terminated..
8. CCFS reserves the right to deny any visit for inmates or visitors.
9. All visitors will be checked for outstanding criminal and civil processes.
10. Visits will be cancelled due to disciplinary reasons. You will not be able to visit until the inmate has served his/her disciplinary time and returns to population. Check email often for cancellations. The visit cannot be granted if you show up for the scheduled visitation.
11. All persons entering the premises are subject to search.
12. No personal belongings, food or beverages will be allowed in the visiting area. **CELL PHONES ARE NOT PERMITTED.** Visitors caught with a cell phone will be asked to leave and have future visits suspended. Visitors requiring medical necessary items, such as inhalers, nitroglycerin tablets, wheelchairs/walkers, and insulin pumps will be allowed to carry them into visitation.
13. Visitors are expected to be courteous to other visitors. Loud talking, excessive emotionalism, or any other type of disruptive behavior will not be permitted. Failure to comply will result in termination of the session and result in suspension of future visits.
14. Visitors must remain seated during the visit. Standing in the visitation booth or stacking chairs is prohibited. No profanity is allowed. Visitors are expected to behave in an appropriate manner during visitation. A visitor who demonstrates inappropriate conduct while visiting, will be permanently banned from any future visitation. Inappropriate conduct shall be defined as:
 - Exposure of sexual organs (to include female breasts)
 - Obvious physical impairment caused by drugs and/or alcohol and
 - any other action that could compromise the security or orderly operation of the facility
15. Upon the conclusion of your visitation session you are to leave the facility
16. Loitering in the building/parking lot or on the property will not be permitted.
17. Failure to follow any of the above rules may cause suspension or revocation of visitation privileges.

All visitors are expected to strictly follow the dress code. Any persons violating the dress code will be asked to leave.

VISITORS MUST BE AGE 18 TO SCHEDULE A VISIT. IF YOU REGISTERED AN UNDERAGE PERSON THEY WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO VISIT.
