### Operation Drive Sober Results in 25 Drunken Driver Arrests 833 repeat offenders since January 2010





Milwaukee, WI – At the start of this year, Sheriff David A. Clarke Jr. ordered an aggressive weekend Driving Under the Influence (DUI) initiative to rid the Milwaukee County freeway system of drunken drivers.

The repeat offenders this weekend included one DUI-5<sup>th</sup>, one DUI-4<sup>th</sup>, one DUI-3<sup>rd</sup> and four DUI-2<sup>nd</sup>, one who crashed her vehicle on the freeway.

**Nancy Rehbein, age 55, of West Allis, was arrested for DUI-5<sup>th</sup> on Saturday after a deputy observed her deviating lanes westbound on W. College Avenue at 2:30 a.m. She was taken to the County Correctional Facility-Central and faces up to six years in prison if convicted of this Class H Felony. Her prior DUI arrests occurred in March 1998, October 1999, March 2000 and June 2008.**

**Kevin Diaz, age 38, of Milwaukee, was arrested for his fourth offense and Ryan Povlick, age 26, of Greendale, was arrested for his third offense.**

**Charisse Kirby, age 26, of Milwaukee, crashed her vehicle into the median wall on I-43 northbound, just north of Hampton Avenue at about 3:40 a.m. on Saturday. She suffered minor injuries.**

**Others arrested for their second offense include: Leighann Eason, age 22, of Milwaukee, Shawna Turley, age 32, of South Milwaukee, and Nicholas St. Onge, age 25, of Hales Corners.**

**The following 18 were first offenders: Milwaukee residents Jermain Caine, age 29, Janet R. Taylor, age 38, Gregory Bissen, age 43, and Torrell Ware, age 33. West Allis residents: Craig Quinn, age 54, Byron Bock, age 31, and Amanda Elliot, age 21. Waukesha residents: Eric Hafferman, age 38, Joshua Lang, age 30, and Marc Richter, age 24. Others receiving their DUI-1<sup>st</sup> were Eric Milia, age 33, of Franklin, Jenson Kuriakose, age 38, and Angela Wellsmith, age 37, of Brookfield, Daniel Pankau, age 23, of West Bend, Dusan Pandzic, age 26, of Lake Villa, IL, Melinda Santoyo, age 38, of Oak Creek, Bryn Hase, age 30, of Wauwatosa, and Lisa Dietz, age 31 of Muskego.**

**Representative Jim Ott and Senator Alberta Darling have co-sponsored a bill in the Wisconsin Legislature to make it even tougher for drunken drivers to escape the consequences of their actions. We have enough laws to deter this behavior; the bill will prevent judges from finding loopholes to avoid handing out stiffer sentences.**

**Deputies will STOP, TEST, and ARREST everyone suspected of impaired driving.**
