Passenger Suffers Severe Injuries in OWI Crash



Milwaukee, WI – Milwaukee County Sheriff deputies responded to a one-car crash eastbound I-794 on the ramp to southbound I-794 at about 2:15 a.m. Sunday.

At the scene, deputies detected a strong odor of alcohol on the driver's breath, along with red, glassy eyes and slurred speech. Deputies conducted standardized field sobriety tests on the driver, Quentin Stacy, age 36, which he failed. The result of the PBT was .18, more than twice the legal limit. Stacy was transported to Froedtert Memorial Lutheran Hospital for a blood draw.

The female passenger in the 1965 Chevrolet Corvair was not wearing a seatbelt and suffered serious injuries, including numerous facial fractures.

Stacy faces charges of Injury by Intoxicated Use of a Vehicle – Causing Great Bodily Harm, a Class F Felony punishable by up to 12 ½-years imprisonment, and citations for Operating While Intoxicated 1st (\$821.00) and Failure to Control (\$216.60).
