17 Arrested for Drunken Driving - DUI-3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, and 13 DUI-1st

Milwaukee, WI – Sheriff's deputies stopped 17 drunken drivers this weekend, four who were involved in crashes. Repeat driving under the influence (DUI) offenders included a DUI-3rd, 4th, DUI-5th, and a DUI-6th in a stolen vehicle. Deputies arrested a DUI-1st with a nine-year-old child in the car, and issued citations to twelve other DUI-1st offenders.

At 9:35 p.m. on Friday, deputies responded to a 911 call about a driver swerving on US-45 northbound at Hampton. They stopped Amy Berger, age 39, of Germantown at Mill Road. She admitted consuming alcohol and taking prescription medications. The 9-year-old child in her car was taken to the Patrol Substation and picked up by her father. Berger faces up to six months in jail if convicted on a charge of DUI-1st with Juvenile in Vehicle.

A deputy spotted a vehicle deviating lanes in the Zoo Interchange at 2:00 a.m. Saturday, and stopped the driver after he exited on Watertown Plank Road at 92nd Street. The deputy called for backup for a felony stop when a check showed the vehicle had been stolen. Nicholas D. Glover, age 34, of Milwaukee, registered a .16 on the intoximeter, and is being charged with DUI-6th. His prior DUI arrests occurred in May, July, August, October and November of 2008 in South Dakota. He faces up to six years in prison if convicted of this sixth DUI offense. Sheriff's detectives are investigating the stolen vehicle case, and have pending Possession of Cocaine and Possession of Marijuana charges against both the driver and his passenger for drugs found under the dashboard during a search of the vehicle.

At 2:55 a.m. Saturday, a deputy stopped a vehicle near the intersection of E. Howard and S. Kingan avenues, and arrested Paul J. Porter, age 37, of Milwaukee, for DUI-5th. His prior DUI arrests occurred in March 1995, April 1995, March 1997, and October 2006. He faces up to six years in prison if convicted of this fifth offense.

Deputies stopped a vehicle traveling at speeds in excess of 80 mph and deviating lanes at 3:30 a.m. Saturday on I-94 eastbound at Hawley Road. The driver, Rafael Rosales, age 40, of Milwaukee, admitted to drinking alcohol and smoking marijuana. He was arrested for DUI-4th, with his prior arrests occurring in September 1996, January 1999 and December 2005. The 2005 conviction included Injury by Intoxicated Use of a Vehicle. Rosales has an extensive criminal history, including operating an auto without owner's consent, battery, violation of domestic abuse order, and sexual assault of a child. If convicted on this DUI-4th offense, Rosales faces up to one year in jail.
