### **Teen Arrested for OWI with Minor Passengers Three Passengers Also Cited for Underage Drinking**

Milwaukee, WI – Milwaukee County sheriff's deputies responded to a 911 call at 1:48 a.m. Sunday regarding a possible OWI on I-43. A deputy observed the car deviating lanes and stopped the vehicle southbound on 35<sup>th</sup> Street at National Avenue.

The 17-year-old driver tested .12 on the PBT. She was arrested for OWI-1<sup>st</sup> – with Minor Passenger. An 18-year-old male passenger was issued a citation for Underage Alcohol and conveyed to the County Correctional Facility-Central to be booked and released.

The two 15-year-old female passengers were both cited for Underage Alcohol. One of them also received a county citation for Possession of Marijuana.

All four teens reside in Illinois. Child Protective Services (CPS) was called after parents for the 15-year-old subjects refused to pick up their children. The CPS worker directed deputies to turn the girls over to Children's Detention Center until the parents could pick them up. Children's Detention Service would not accept them because they had not been arrested for state charges. CPS eventually took custody of the girls from the Patrol Division substation at 5:25 a.m.

The 17-year-old driver, if convicted, faces 6 months in jail and up to two years probation, and license revocation up to 18 months.
