Media Staging Areas for Deputy Sergio Aleman's Funeral

Milwaukee, WI – The Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office is appealing to media outlets to refrain from having helicopters fly over the burial service. The noise from the helicopters prevents those attending from hearing the speakers and the Honor Guard from hearing commands. There is ample opportunity to get footage of the squad procession from Miller Park to the church, and the beginning of the procession from the church up to the cemetery. We have made the following arrangements for media staging at each location:

- Monday, August 6

MEDIA STAGING AREAS - Visitation

Media staging will be at the PyraMax Bank, located at 9000 W. Drexel Boulevard. The staging area is NOT open for the media to set up until 5 PM, after business hours. No other staging will be available before this time.

- Tuesday, August 7

MEDIA STAGING AREAS - Service

St. Patrick's Catholic Church
723 W. Washington Avenue, Milwaukee, WI

Media staging will be on S. 7th Street between W. Madison Avenue and W. Scott Street. Media should plan to be in place no later than 10:00 a.m. Media should approach from the south. Media is not allowed inside the church.

LAW ENFORCEMENT PROCESSION ROUTE

Law enforcement agencies will be staging squads at Miller Park 'Uecker' parking lot for the procession due to very limited parking in the neighborhood surrounding the church. These squads will leave Miller Park when the service is coming to a close to begin the procession. This is expected to be shortly before 1:00 p.m., depending on length of church service.

Squads will be escorted from Miller Park, east on Canal Street to S. 6th Street, south on S. 6th Street to W. Washington Avenue, and then follow the procession from the church. The procession will continue south on S. 6th Street to St. Adalbert's Cemetery.

MEDIA STAGING AREAS - Burial

**St. Adalbert's Cemetery
3801 S. 6th Street, Milwaukee, WI**

Media staging will be on W. Warnimont Avenue between S. 5th Place and S. 6th Street. Media should plan to be in place by no later than 1:00 p.m. Media should approach from W. Howard Avenue on S. 5th Place, north to W. Warnimont Avenue.

Media will NOT be allowed onto the cemetery grounds.
