Operation Drive Sober Results in 19 Drunken Driver Arrests 809 Repeat Offenders since January 2010

Milwaukee, WI – Sheriff David A. Clarke Jr. ordered increased weekend Driving Under the Influence (DUI) patrols to arrest drunken drivers. The initiative, Operative Drive Sober, resulted in deputies taking 19 drunken drivers off the road this weekend.

The highly aggressive effort to make our freeway system a safer place to drive for sober motorists included arrests of eight repeat DUI offenders, one driver who was involved in a crash on I-43 northbound at 13th Street and sustained minor injuries.

On Friday, February 15, 2013, at about 10:20 p.m., arrested Terrance J. Dulek, age 63, of Milwaukee, for his sixth DUI after observing Dulek's vehicle deviate from its lane northbound on I-894 near W. Greenfield Avenue. Dulek said he had consumed "two beers." His prior DUI arrests occurred in August 2002, June 2004, August 2004, September 2004 and March 2007. If convicted of his sixth offense, a Class H felony, Dulek faces up to six years in prison.

A deputy stopped a vehicle going 73mph in a 50mph zone westbound I-94 near Mitchell Boulevard at 1:45 a.m. today. Dejuan E. Curry, age 33, of West Allis, was arrested for his fourth DUI, his last within five years, making this a felony charge with up to six years in prison if convicted. He was also charged with Operating After Revocation-OWI Related, a misdemeanor which carries a penalty of up to 90 days in jail. His prior drunken driving arrests occurred in May 2006, August 2010 and January 2011.

Other repeat offenders included six arrested for their 2nd offense: Joseph J. Mitchell, age 28, of St. Francis, Jay Xiong, age 31, of Milwaukee, Jessica Sakac, age 30, of Germantown, April Ayala, age 23, of Watertown, who was involved in a crash northbound I-43 at 13th Street, and from Milwaukee, Gerardo Perez-Antunes, age 45, and Eradio Hernandez-Galvez, age 26.

Deputies will STOP, TEST, and ARREST those suspected of driving drunk.

The initiative was conducted using the resources of the MCSO Patrol Division, additional alcohol grant squads, MCSO OWI Task Force, and Targeted Enforcement Unit (TEU) squads. These resources will continue to be deployed to combat and minimize the alcohol, speed and aggressive driving incidents on the freeway system.
