Operation Drive Sober Results in 14 Drunken Driver Arrests 883 Repeat Offenders Since January 2010

Milwaukee, WI – At the start of this year, Sheriff David A. Clarke Jr. ordered an aggressive weekend Driving Under the Influence (DUI) initiative to rid the Milwaukee County freeway system of drunken drivers.

This weekend's initiative from Friday at 6:00 p.m. through Sunday at 6:00 a.m. resulted in the arrest of 14 drunken drivers. Three of these were repeat offenders. Demetrick Fleming, age 36 of Milwaukee and Randy Johns, age 29, Cudahy, were arrested for DUI-3rd offense. Tiffany Carter-McClain, age 30, of Milwaukee, was arrested for DUI-2nd offense.

Eleven first-time offenders were booked. Milwaukee residents Christopher Carlson, age 32; Brandon Harrell, age 23;; James Moore, age 24; Mary Yang, age 21; Amanda Meyer, age 30; and Timothy Schmitz, age 39.

Other first-time offenders included Semir Malagic, age 22, of Chicago; Shannon Iverson, age 24, of West Allis; Shawna Carl, age 38, of South Milwaukee; Rebecca Berger, age 32, of Wauwatosa; and Jose Diosdado, age 24, of Glendale.

Representative Jim Ott and Senator Alberta Darling have co-sponsored a bill in the Wisconsin Legislature to make it even tougher for drunken drivers to escape the consequences of their actions. The bill will prevent judges from finding loopholes to avoid handing out stiffer sentences. Deputies will STOP, TEST, and ARREST everyone suspected of impaired driving.
