Two Women Arrested in Disturbance at Child Support Office Deputy Uses Taser on Combative Subject

Milwaukee, WI – Yesterday at 12:50 p.m., sheriff's deputies responded to a disturbance that began in the Child Support Enforcement (CSE) office at the county courthouse and continued in the hallway. Two women, Jacqueline Robinson, age 22, and Meauto Perryman, age 31, both of Milwaukee, were involved in a verbal argument that escalated into a physical altercation.

Based on witness statements, video and statements of the subjects involved, Perryman began to speak aggressively to Robinson as the latter signed in at the CSE office. Perryman's niece, Shameka Goodman, age 24, of Milwaukee, and Robinson each have a child by the same man.

Robinson left to wait in the hall and was followed by Perryman. Robinson struck Perryman in the face, and both began punching each other, landing on the floor fighting until deputies separated them. Robinson had visible injuries to her face and said she is six months pregnant. She was conveyed to Sinai Samaritan Hospital by ambulance.

Perryman resisted arrest, flailing her arms, using profane language, and moving aggressively toward a deputy. She refused to comply with orders and a deputy deployed her Taser on Perryman after several commands to stop resisting were ignored.

Robinson and Perryman were arrested for Battery and Disorderly Conduct, with penalties of up to one year imprisonment. They both have prior disorderly conduct arrests.

Perryman faces additional charges of Resisting/Obstructing which carries an additional 9 months imprisonment.

The third woman involved, Goodman, was issued a citation for disorderly conduct for screaming obscenities.
