Operation Drive Sober Results in 11 Arrests 987 Repeat Offenders Since January 2010

Milwaukee, WI – At the start of this year, Sheriff David A. Clarke Jr. ordered an aggressive weekend Driving Under the Influence (DUI) initiative to rid the Milwaukee County freeway system of drunken drivers.

This weekend's initiative from Friday at 4:00 p.m. through Sunday at 6:00 a.m. resulted in the arrest of 11 drunken drivers. The average PBT result was .11.

One repeat offender, Eric Stolz, age 29, of Milwaukee, was arrested for DUI-3rd after he was involved in a hit and run crash in which he struck another vehicle with his motorcycle on the I-794 on ramp at S. Carferry Drive.

Ten people were arrested for their first offense: Milwaukee residents Amanda Bruns, age 23; Nitpreet Kolhi, age 24; and Megan Wagner, age 30. Other DUI-1st offenders included Joshua Schroeckenthaler, age 38, of Mequon; William Lewis, age 34, of Menomonee Falls; Gilberto Gil Santiago, age 21, of Pewaukee; Debbie Davis, age 46, of West Allis; Tracy Schweitzer, age 22, of Racine; Angelique Zweber, age 27, of Waukesha; and David Zierden, age 42, of Franklin.
