Operation Drive Sober Results in 9 Arrests, 1 Felony-4th Offender 998 Repeat Offenders Since January 2010



Afshin Farzadram – felony-4th

Milwaukee, WI – At the start of this year, Sheriff David A. Clarke Jr. ordered an aggressive weekend Driving Under the Influence (DUI) initiative to rid the Milwaukee County freeway system of drunken drivers.

This weekend's initiative from Friday at 4:00 p.m. through Sunday at 6:00 a.m. resulted in the arrest of nine drunken drivers. The average PBT result was .13.

On Saturday, October 19, at 3:42 a.m., a deputy arrested Afshin Farzadram, age 42, of Milwaukee, for a felony DUI-4th offense. The deputy observed Farzadram deviating lanes and driving below the speed limit at 42 mph on northbound I-43 and Lincoln Ave. He was stopped at W. National Ave. and S. 9th St. He had a result of .186 on the PBT at the scene.

Farzadram's previous convictions were in March 1995, November 2001 and November 2008. He faces up to six years in prison if convicted on this felony DUI-4th charge.

The other eight DUI arrests were all first-time offenders: Milwaukee resident Nathan Mouthey, age 26; Amir Aganovic, age 21, and Jose Veloz, age 42, of Greenfield; and Margaret Guinn, age 22, of Whitefish Bay. Four of those arrested were underage drinkers: Amy Silva, age 19, of Waukesha; Chad Hoffman, age 20, of Sussex; John Pokey, age 20, of Menomonee Falls; and Kristin Brooks, age 20, of Racine.
