Operation Drive Sober Results in 11 Arrests 1007 Repeat Offenders Since January 2010

Milwaukee, WI – At the start of this year, Sheriff David A. Clarke Jr. ordered an aggressive weekend Driving Under the Influence (DUI) initiative to rid the Milwaukee County freeway system of drunken drivers.

This weekend's initiative from Friday at 4:00 p.m. through Sunday at 6:00 a.m. resulted in the arrest of 11 drunken drivers. The average PBT result was .12.

Repeat offenders included Cameron Naab, age 23, of Germantown with his third DUI; and underage drinker Rafael Sixteco-Gutierrez, age 20, of Milwaukee, for his second offense.

Three first-time offenders from Milwaukee were involved in crashes. Adam Van Gorder, age 25, wound up in a ditch; Kyle Armstrong, age 23, hit a median wall; and Samuel Markwardt, age 24, was involved in a crash. Other DUI-1st offenders from Milwaukee included Ubencio Alvarez, age 27; Omelio Hopwood, age 26; and Marcus Parker, age 23.

Underage drinker Rachel Schumitsch, age 20, of West Allis; Cassandra Niles, age 22, of Appleton; and Joseph Kusch, age 32, of New Berlin were also cited for DUI-1st.
