Fatal Crash on I-43 at Highway 100

Milwaukee, WI – The Sheriff's Office dispatch advised squads of a rollover crash eastbound I-43 near Highway 100 at 10:41 a.m. today.

The driver of the vehicle, Tammy Gawlitta, age 39, of West Allis, had been ejected from passenger side window of the Dodge Durango and was trapped under the vehicle in a ditch. Two good Samaritans lifted the vehicle off its side and pushed it upright. They attempted CPR on the victim, but were unable to revive her.

Greenfield Fire Department rescue units also attempted CPR when they arrived on scene.

A three-year-old passenger was in a car seat and suffered only a minor injury, but was transported to Children's Hospital for precautionary reasons.

Waukesha County Sheriff's Department closed the freeway west of the crash location, diverting all traffic off at W. Layton Avenue until just before 2:00 p.m. while sheriff's detectives conducted their investigation of the scene.

There is no traffic camera video of the crash.
