Operation Drive Sober Results in 5 Arrests 1030 Repeat Offenders Since January 2010

Milwaukee, WI – At the start of this year, Sheriff David A. Clarke Jr. ordered an aggressive weekend Driving Under the Influence (DUI) initiative to rid the Milwaukee County freeway system of drunken drivers.

This weekend's initiative from Friday at 4:00 p.m. through Sunday at 6:00 a.m. resulted in the arrest of five drunken drivers, with one repeat offender and one driving the wrong way on a freeway off ramp, crashing his vehicle. The average PBT result was .14.

Jonathan Seelen, age 26, of Milwaukee, was arrested for DUI-2nd.

Chandan Agrawal, age 24, of Franklin, drove the wrong way on the I-94 76th Street off ramp, turned around at the top of the ramp and crashed his vehicle on concrete construction barriers near 84th Street. Agrawal denied he had been drinking alcohol, but tested .18 on the intoximeter. Agrawal faces a charge of Recklessly Endangering Safety, with potential imprisonment of up to ten years.

Other first-time offenders included Calvin Hunter, age 30, of Racine; Thomas Gustafson, age 58, of New Berlin; and Tobias Cole, age 22, of Madison.
