Sheriff's Advisory for People Traveling to Sunday's Packers Game

Milwaukee, WI – Thousands of people will be traveling to Green Bay for the game on Sunday. The reality is people still venture out, even in adverse weather conditions.

“Here’s what I need motorists to think about,” said Sheriff David Clarke. “I need you to pre-plan. Think three “C’s” - 1) Cars, 2) Clothing, 3) Cell phone.

Have jumper cables in your car. Cars do not always work well mechanically in these severe temperatures and may quit on you unexpectedly. Ask yourself if you’re prepared to withstand in these situations. Wear clothing designed for extreme cold weather conditions, especially if you have children traveling with you. Now is not the time to look cute. You may not feel the damage due to skin exposure or hypothermia until it is too late. Make sure your cell phone is fully charged before leaving home so you can handle the numerous calls you may need to make if you become stranded.”

An increase in traffic incidents in severe weather has a tendency to tax our limited resources. So if law enforcement response is delayed, these are things you can do to survive until deputies can get there.
