Operation Drive Sober Results in 7 Arrests 1050 Repeat Offenders Since January 2010

Milwaukee, WI – At the start of last year, Sheriff David A. Clarke Jr. ordered an aggressive weekend Driving Under the Influence (DUI) initiative to rid the Milwaukee County freeway system of drunken drivers.

This weekend's initiative from Friday at 4:00 p.m. through Sunday at 6:00 a.m. resulted in the arrest of seven drunken drivers, with two repeat offenders. The average PBT result was .14.

On Friday, January 31, at about 4:30 p.m., a deputy notified dispatch of a vehicle speeding eastbound on a closed portion of Watertown Plank Road, ignoring barricades and signs indicating the closure. David R. Cashmore, age 54, of Greenfield, was arrested for DUI-3rd with a PBT result of .19. During a search, the deputy found cocaine base in Cashmore's pocket.

Cashmore was booked on charges of Possession of Cocaine/2nd Offense-felony, and DUI-3rd. His previous convictions were in August 1990 and March 2007. If convicted, he faces up to four years imprisonment.
