Operation Drive Sober Results in 3 Arrests Man Crashes on Freeway, Arrested for Felony 5th DUI Offense 1073 Repeat Offenders Since January 2010



Milwaukee, WI – At the start of last year, Sheriff David A. Clarke Jr. ordered an aggressive weekend Driving Under the Influence (DUI) initiative to rid the Milwaukee County freeway system of drunken drivers.

This weekend's initiative from Friday at 4:00 p.m. through Sunday at 6:00 a.m. resulted in the arrest of three drunken drivers, one a DUI-5th offense. The average PBT result was .16.

Michael Anderson, age 40, of West Allis, was arrested Friday, February 28, shortly before 11:00 p.m. after he crashed his Pontiac Firebird on I-94 westbound just west of Hawley Road. Anderson's vehicle left the freeway, went over an embankment and crashed through a chain link fence. He said he had been drinking at Classic Lanes, 7501 S. Howell Avenue, in Oak Creek.

Anderson has four prior drunken driving convictions in January 1993, October 1998, March 1999 and July 2005, and is under a restriction to have a blood alcohol concentration (BAC) of .02 or less. He tested .11 on a PBT. If convicted of the felony DUI-5th, he faces up to six years in prison.

First-time offenders were Tiffany Young, age 35, of Glendale; and Diego Coria, age 23, of Cudahy.
