Operation Drive Sober Results in 11 Arrests 1093 Repeat Offenders Since January 2010

Milwaukee, WI – At the start of last year, Sheriff David A. Clarke Jr. ordered an aggressive weekend Driving Under the Influence (DUI) initiative to rid the Milwaukee County freeway system of drunken drivers.

This weekend's initiative from Friday at 4:00 p.m. through Sunday at 6:00 a.m. resulted in the arrest of eleven drunken drivers, with two repeat offenders. The average PBT result was .14.

The two repeat offenders were Nevalle Swan, age 43, of Milwaukee, who was arrested for DUI-3rd; and Adam Gutschenritter, age 25, of Iron Ridge, Michigan, who was arrested for DUI-2nd.

Milwaukee residents charged with DUI-1st included: Gerardo Marin Sanchez, age 21; Beth Berndt, age 33; Rachel Johnson, age 23; Terry Jones, age 62; and Nathan Atkins, age 32. Other first-time offenders included Andrea Gohr, age 24, of Brookfield; Danielle Stephens, age 26, of Muskego; and Cudahy residents Nicole Hanson, age 33; and Brian Peltier, age 35.
