Operation Drive Sober Results in 14 Arrests, 4 Repeat Offenders 1100 Repeat Offenders Since January 2010

Milwaukee, WI – At the start of last year, Sheriff David A. Clarke Jr. ordered an aggressive weekend Driving Under the Influence (DUI) initiative to rid the Milwaukee County freeway system of drunken drivers.

This weekend's initiative from Friday at 4:00 p.m. through Sunday at 6:00 a.m. resulted in the arrest of 14 drunken drivers, with four repeat offenders. The average PBT result was .15.

The four repeat offenders were Craig Strowig, age 39, of Colgate, arrested for DUI-4th ; Robert Rosenow, age 39, of West Allis, for DUI-3rd; and two-time offenders Zachary Henry, age 26, of Franklin; and Cory Price, age 20, of Wauwatosa.

First time offenders from Milwaukee were: Holly Becker, age 24; Richard Mills, age 75; Irma Castaneda, age 29; Deja Scott, age 23; Fred Prather, age 27; and Kevin Brown, age 21. Other first-time offenders were Joshua Malone, age 36, of Hales Corners; Eli Martinez-Enciso, age 32, of Kenosha; Anthony Tumidajewicz, age 25, of West Allis; and Joseph Wisneski, age 29, of Oconomowoc.
