Operation Drive Sober Results in 7 Arrests, 2 Repeat Offenders 1108 Repeat Offenders Since January 2010

Milwaukee, WI – At the start of last year, Sheriff David A. Clarke Jr. ordered an aggressive weekend Driving Under the Influence (DUI) initiative to rid the Milwaukee County freeway system of drunken drivers.

This weekend's initiative from Friday at 4:00 p.m. through Sunday at 6:00 a.m. resulted in the arrest of seven drunken drivers, with two repeat offenders. The average PBT result was .11.

Repeat offenders were Milwaukee residents Jose Guerrero, age 32, for DUI-3rd; and Carrie Bernard, age 34, for DUI-2nd.

Jerome Walker, age 27, of Milwaukee, was involved in a rollover crash on US-145 northbound at the 107th Street off ramp on Saturday at 4:10 a.m. After a .09 PBT test, he resisted arrest, struggled with the deputy who was handcuffing him, causing them to fall to the ground, and injuring the deputy. Walker fled the scene on foot, and was stopped by an MPD squad on Fond du Lac Avenue. Deputies took him into custody and found nine baggies of marijuana in his pocket.

First-time offenders were Jose Martinez, age 31, of Franklin; and Milwaukee residents Alexander Anquil, age 23; Matthew Koch, age 24; and Melanye Chandler, age 25.
