Sheriff Clarke to Join Ald. Donovan's "Operation Alley Cat" Announcement

Milwaukee, WI – Sheriff David A. Clarke Jr. will join Alderman Bob Donovan at the launch of the alderman's "Operation Alley Cat" initiative tomorrow, Wednesday, April 23, at 1:30 p.m.

Ald. Donovan's project will add surveillance cameras to specific alley locations in the area of the news conference, which will take place in the alley behind 1105 S. 36th Street (located between W. Scott and W. National, from 36th to 37th streets). Donovan has also invited neighborhood residents and the Milwaukee Police Department to attend.

Donovan said a partnership with We Energies, "Operation Impact," in the Silver City/Burnham Park neighborhood, has provided 'an extra measure of safety' after dark, and a tool to fight crime. According to the alderman, the privately-funded surveillance cameras will be installed at several locations during the pilot phase of Operation Alley Cat, providing footage that will be monitored by MPD.

The target area is located in the 2nd Police District and is bounded by W. Pierce Street on the north, W. Lincoln Avenue on the south, S. 16th Street/S. Cesar Chavez Drive on the east, and S. 38th Street on the west.
