### **Deputies Arrest 7 Drunken Drivers in Operation Drive Sober Wrong-way Drunken Driver Stopped by Deputy 1300 Repeat Offenders Since January 2010**

Milwaukee, WI – Sheriff David A. Clarke Jr. has ordered a continued aggressive weekend Driving Under the Influence (DUI) initiative to rid the Milwaukee County freeway system of drunken drivers. This weekend's Operation Drive Sober initiative, from Friday at 4:00 p.m. through Sunday at 6:00 a.m., resulted in the arrest of seven drunken drivers. The average PBT result was .14.

All seven drunken drivers were cited for DUI-1<sup>st</sup> offense: Brian Lehmann, age 24, of South Milwaukee; Bogard Garcia, age 31, of Chicago; Fidel Gonzalez-Sanchez, age 23, of East Alton; and Milwaukee residents Sterling Orr, age 26; Jesse Stenbrotten, age 24; Anthony Lozito, age 24; and Eugenio Jiminez-Martinez, age 22.

#### **Wrong-way drunken driver**

On Saturday, April 25 at 4:00 a.m., a deputy traveling southbound on I-43 south of North Avenue saw a vehicle heading northbound toward her squad. The deputy activated her emergency lights and siren and took a blocking position against the wrong way driver. The driver, Eugenio Jiminez-Martinez, stopped and did not strike the squad.

He was cited for Operating without a Valid License, Driving the Wrong Way on a Divided Highway, and faces a felony charge of 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Recklessly Endangering Safety, which carries a prison term of up to 10 years.**
