Deputies Arrest 9 Drunken Drivers in Operation Drive Sober 1321 Repeat Offenders Since January 2010



Houston Wilson – DUI-5th

Milwaukee, WI – Sheriff David A. Clarke Jr. has ordered a continued aggressive weekend Driving Under the Influence (DUI) initiative to rid the Milwaukee County freeway system of drunken drivers. This weekend's Operation Drive Sober initiative, from Friday at 4:00 p.m. through Sunday at 6:00 a.m., resulted in the arrest of nine drunken drivers, one who was arrested for a felony DUI-5th offense. The average PBT result was .12.

On Friday, May 29, at about 9:30 p.m., a caller stated he was following a possible drunken driver. Squads responded and stopped the vehicle on S. 6th Street and Layton Avenue. Houston Wilson, age 70, of Greenfield, was arrested for DUI-5th offense. Wilson has four previous convictions for drunken driving in June 1998, August 2000, February 2002, and August 2005. He said he was drinking at a bar on 29th and North Avenue, but did not remember the name of the bar.

Eight first-time offenders were taken into custody: Andrew Dykema, age 46, of Cedarburg; Katherine Walters, age 33, of Hales Corners; Catherine Murphy, age 36, of Franklin; Ashley Davis, age 24, of Waukesha; and Milwaukee residents Elmer Telles-Feliz, age 27; Izell Allen, age 25; Caitlin Wolf, age 27; and Oscar Colin, age 23.
