Man Charged in Drug Case Stemming from Lakefront Traffic Stop



Milwaukee, WI – Luis J. Lorenzo, age 28, of Milwaukee, was charged today with a Class E felony Possession with Intent to Deliver Controlled Substance (Cocaine) Second and Subsequent Offense.

On Tuesday April 8, 2014 at about 6:45 p.m., a sheriff's deputy with the Targeted Enforcement Unit performed a traffic stop at 2500 N. Lincoln Memorial Dr. The driver's license was suspended, and there was an odor of marijuana in the vehicle. Lorenzo admitted to smoking marijuana earlier, but said there were no drugs in the car. A vehicle search turned up a plastic bag of more than 7 grams of cocaine and a digital scale hidden in a removable panel behind the passenger seat. Clear plastic bags consistent with street level narcotic sales were found in the trunk.

He faces a maximum penalty of 15 years in prison if convicted of this charge, plus four years for being a subsequent offender.
