Operation Drive Sober Results in 16 Arrests 1140 Repeat Offenders Since January 2010

Milwaukee, WI – At the start of last year, Sheriff David A. Clarke Jr. ordered an aggressive weekend Driving Under the Influence (DUI) initiative to rid the Milwaukee County freeway system of drunken drivers.

This weekend's initiative, from Friday at 4:00 p.m. through Sunday at 6:00 a.m., resulted in the arrest of 16 drunken drivers, with three repeat offenders. The average PBT result was .14.

Leonardo Mandujano, age 39, of Racine, was arrested for DUI-3rd. Christopher Peters, age 24, of Brookfield, and John Canterbury, age 47, of Milwaukee, were both arrested for DUI-2nd.

First-time offenders were Milwaukee residents Antonio Walker, age 41; Miguel Rodriguez, age 32; Eugene Harper, age 57; Saif Ali, age 20; Jerry Smith, age 41; and Francisco Reyes, age 44. Also cited with DUI-1st offense were Thomas Petersen, age 23, of Trevor; Randall Beatty, age 29, of West Allis; Noelani Lumley, age 25, of Glendale; Earl Slowik, age 41, of Brookfield; Robert Korom, age 28, of Somerville, MA; Taylor Anthonson, age 22, of Kenosha; and Viktor Ryabchuk, age 24, of Wauwatosa.
