### Deputies Arrest 8 Drunken Drivers in Operation Drive Sober DUI-4<sup>th</sup>, and a Wrong Way DUI-1<sup>st</sup> 1334 Repeat Offenders Since January 2010

Milwaukee, WI – Sheriff David A. Clarke Jr. has ordered a continued aggressive weekend Driving Under the Influence (DUI) initiative to rid the Milwaukee County freeway system of drunken drivers. This weekend's Operation Drive Sober initiative, from Friday at 4:00 p.m. through Sunday at 6:00 a.m., resulted in the arrest of eight drunken drivers, one who is a repeat offender, and one who drove the wrong way on I-43. The average PBT result was .13.

Daniel Schaefer, age 55, of Brown Deer, was arrested for DUI-4<sup>th</sup> offense. First-time offenders were Amber Kowalik, age 22, of Greenfield, Daniel Crocker, age 19, of Roscoe, Illinois; Todd Jones, age 52, of Milwaukee; Brendan O'Connell, age 31, of Santa Monica, California; Marco Sanchez, age 23, of Monona; and Allan McFadyen, age 44, of Germantown.

A wrong-way drunken driver was also arrested for DUI-1<sup>st</sup> offense today at about 2:20 a.m. Deshun Peet, age 24, of Milwaukee, had a PBT result of .14, and said he had two beers at Brother's Bar and Grill at 1213 N. Water Street. A deputy saw a Chevy Blazer swerving on I-43 near Silver Spring Drive and attempted to stop the vehicle. The driver exited the freeway at Silver Spring, and turned onto the south I-43 off ramp against traffic. The deputy accelerated ahead of the vehicle and blocked it from continuing onto the freeway about 100 feet up the ramp.
