### **Deputy Injured in Motorcycle Crash**

Milwaukee, WI – Yesterday, at about 4:30 p.m., a deputy providing motorcycle escort for the Concerns of Police Survivors participants from General Mitchell International Airport to the camp in East Troy, suffered minor injuries when his motorcycle crashed.

The 46-year-old deputy, a 19-year MCSO veteran, was stopped and as he pulled out into the roadway at County Highway ES and Army Lake Road, the rear wheel hit gravel, and sent the deputy airborne. Town of East Troy Fire medical units transported the deputy to the hospital, where he was treated and released. Town of East Troy police department performed the crash investigation.

Deputies and police officers from all over Wisconsin provide the escort for the annual C.O.P.S. (Concerns of Police Survivors) camp as the participants depart General Mitchell International Airport to the weeklong camp in East Troy. C.O.P.S. is a national organization that assists families of fallen officers.

Family members are left to cope with the tragic loss, but C.O.P.S. Inc, a nonprofit organization, helps grieving families rebuild their lives. Dozens of children from around the country pass through General Mitchell International Airport as they head to the summer camp for young survivors.
