Sheriff's Detectives' Armed Robbery Investigation Leads to Arrest of Parks Employee in Inside Job

Milwaukee, WI – Sheriff's Office detectives conducting an armed robbery investigation have arrested two people involved in what turned out to be an inside job theft of more than \$4500.00 from a safe at McCarty Park pool, 2567 S. 79th Street, in West Allis.

On Wednesday, July 23, at about 5:40 p.m., a county park employee reported that he had been approached by two black men with guns who forced him to open the safe after the pool closed. No patrons were at the pool.

Sheriff's detectives determined that Elijah Tucker-Carter, age 18, a Milwaukee County Parks Department employee for about one month, had worked with another subject to concoct the story. Tucker-Carter is facing a felony theft charge, with up to three years and six months in prison. A second subject was arrested on a felony VOP warrant and will face additional charges related to the robbery. Pending the completion of the investigation, his identity is not being released.
