

Operation Drive Sober Results in 10 Arrests, Including DUI-7th DUI-1st-Drugs Driver Strikes Squad on Freeway, Injures Deputy 1172 Repeat Offenders Since January 2010

Milwaukee, WI – At the start of last year, Sheriff David A. Clarke Jr. ordered an aggressive weekend Driving Under the Influence (DUI) initiative to rid the Milwaukee County freeway system of drunken drivers.

This weekend's initiative, from Friday at 4:00 p.m. through Sunday at 6:00 a.m., resulted in the arrest of ten drunken drivers, with three repeat offenders, including a man for his seventh offense. The average PBT result was .15.

This morning, at 2:10 a.m., a vehicle crossed three lanes of traffic and struck a squad that was stopped with a violator on I-43 southbound near West Oklahoma Avenue. The deputy in the squad was taken by ambulance to Froedtert Hospital where he was treated for his injuries and released. Milwaukee Police Department investigated that crash, and arrested James Lee Brown, age 31, of Milwaukee, for DUI-1st/Drugs. Brown will also face a charge of Reckless Driving-Causing Bodily Harm, which has a penalty of up to one year in jail. His vehicle also struck the stopped vehicle at the traffic stop, but the occupants were not injured.

Deputies arrested three repeat offenders during this weekend's Drive Sober initiative. Malcolm Norfleet, age 48, of Milwaukee, was arrested for DUI-7th. A witness found Norfleet asleep in his car with his forehead on the steering wheel on the US-45 northbound Wisconsin Avenue off ramp at about 6:10 p.m. on Saturday. His driver's license was suspended. Norfleet's PBT result was .22.

Norfleet's prior arrests for drunken driving were in April 1999, May 1999, November 2000, May 2006, October 2006 and November 2009. He has an extensive criminal record.

Arrested for their second drunken driving offenses were Elyse Spilker, age 27, of Wauwatosa; and Larry Rogers, age 36, of Milwaukee.

First-time offenders cited were Dana Marifke, age 28, of Oak Creek; Heather Zanon, age 25 of Chilton; Angel Aguilar-Valencia, age 22, of Chicago; Beverly Reuter, age 57, of Katy, Texas; and Milwaukee residents Marques Williams, age 35; Jody Waszkiewicz, age 27; and David Sims, age 57.
