Road Closures for USA Triathlon National Championships

Milwaukee, WI – The Sheriff's Office will coordinate resources and assets with Milwaukee, Cudahy and St. Francis police departments, Milwaukee Fire Department, US Coast Guard, and the county Parks Department on Saturday, August 9, and Sunday, August 10. Milwaukee is the host city for the 2014 USA Triathlon Age Group National Championships. Top amateur triathletes will compete in Lake Michigan and along the lakefront in a combination of run/bike/swim events.

Ramp closures will begin at 5:30 a.m. to clear the racecourse of any traffic leading up to the 7:30 a.m. race start. Barricades will also be set up on arterial city streets leading to Lincoln Memorial Drive and Lincoln Memorial Drive. The anticipated time to reopen is 1:30 p.m. on Saturday and 12:30 p.m. on Sunday.

Closures include:

- At 5:30 a.m., full closure of the Hoan Bridge, to include the entire N/B side of I-794 from Edgerton and Pennsylvania.
- E/B I-794 traffic (to go south over the Hoan Bridge) will be diverted off at the Jackson/Van Buren off-ramp.
- At 7:00 a.m., full closure of Lincoln Memorial Drive and the course route in Cudahy and St. Francis: Along S. Lake Drive from E. Howard to E. Lunham Avenue, south to E. College Avenue.
