Bernabe Torres-Cruz, age 39, of Milwaukee, was arrested for DUI-3rd. Two-time offenders included Milwaukee residents Jesus Marques-Candelaria, age 37; Benicio Marco Macias, age 24; and Mike Brzostowski, age 42. Also arrested for DUI-2nd were Michael Erickson, age 33, of Oconomowoc; Benjamin Esquivel-Sanches, age 21, of Waukesha; and Cody Manchek, age 26, of West Allis.

First-time offenders cited and booked were Tamera Guilinger, age 51, of Elgin, Illinois; Renee Lippitt, age 52, of Muskego; Jessica Brandis, age 24, of South Milwaukee; Matthew Hartz, age 49, of Waukesha; and Milwaukee residents Richard Besch, age 61; Kenneth Deramus, age 58; Ada Monk, age 27; Edwin Garcia, age 40; Andrew Kopplin, age 25; Tatiana Maldonado, age 24; Allen Alston, age 27; underage drinker Nathaniel Schieble, age 18; and Colin Russ, age 21.

On Sunday, August 31, 2014, a deputy stopped a vehicle as it exited US41 northbound, on W. Lisbon Avenue at N. 47th Street. Allen Alston, age 27, of Milwaukee, was arrested for DUI-1st with a .17 PBT, and Recklessly Endangering Safety (RES) for having a loaded gun in the car. If convicted of RES, he faces up to 9 months in jail.

On Friday, August 29, at about 8:30 p.m., Kenneth DeRamus was arrested for DUI-1st with a minor child in the car on the I-94 off ramp near 25th Street.

Three DUI-related crashes occurred, two involving injuries. Cody Manchek, arrested for DUI-2nd was involved in a minor crash and sustained minor injuries. A serious rollover crash forced the closing of I-94 northbound in the Mitchell Interchange at about 4:20 a.m. on Sunday. Benicio Marco Macias was unconscious and suffered head injuries when his car landed on its roof in a lane of traffic. He was transported to Froedtert and arrested for DUI-2nd. The Milwaukee and Oak Creek police departments assisted in closing ramps.
