Deputies Arrest 9 Drunken Drivers in Operation Drive Sober 1394 Repeat Offenders Since January 2010

Milwaukee, WI – Sheriff David A. Clarke Jr. has ordered a continued aggressive weekend Driving Under the Influence (DUI) initiative to rid the Milwaukee County freeway system of drunken drivers. This weekend's Operation Drive Sober initiative, from Friday at 4:00 p.m. through Sunday at 6:00 a.m., resulted in the arrest of nine drunken drivers. One was a repeat offender, and another is being charged with DUI-1st Causing Great Bodily Harm after he crashed his car causing life-threatening injuries to his passenger. The average PBT result was .13.

Jonathon Amel, age 36, of Green Bay, was arrested for DUI-2nd offense. Perry Dockins, age 22, of Milwaukee, was arrested after crashing on Highway 145 southbound near Fond du Lac Avenue, coming to rest in a yard. A 22-year-old male passenger sustained life-threatening injuries. Dockins will be charged with DUI-1st Causing Great Bodily Harm. Two other passengers in the vehicle were not injured.

First-time offenders were Nathan Vogl, age 32, of Brookfield; Edwin Smith, age 24, of Oakwood Hills, IL; Franklin residents Robert Kriskovic, age 32; Jordan Faust, age 26; and Melson Bacos, age 30; and Milwaukee residents Joshua Johnson, age 21; and Jose Perez-Reyes, 32.
