Charges Filed Against Three Subjects Involved in Shooting Incident



Travis Shields Jr. Robert Simmons Jr. April Moore

Milwaukee, WI – The three subjects who fled from a deputy and eventually crashed their vehicle into his squad near Howell and Grange avenues on February 25 were charged today.

The driver, Travis Shields Jr., age 26, of Milwaukee, faces four counts: Possession of a Firearm by a Felon, Fleeing or Eluding an Officer, and two counts of Second Degree Recklessly Endangering Safety. If convicted on all counts, Shields faces up to 33 ½ years in prison. Shields has previous felony convictions for First Degree Reckless Injury and Armed Robbery.

Passenger Robert Simmons Jr., age 27, of Milwaukee, faces one felony count of Possession of a Firearm by a Felon, which carries up to ten years in prison upon conviction. Simmons has a previous felony conviction for Possession of Cocaine with Intent to Deliver.

Passenger April Moore, age 26, of Milwaukee, was charged with a misdemeanor count of Obstructing an Officer for providing false information, and faces up to 9 months in jail.
