The high school charter school, under direction of Dr. Howard Fuller and his staff, this year has 100% of the senior students accepted into 4-year colleges.

Sheriff spoke with many of the students, and visited several classrooms.

Statement from Sheriff Clarke:

“I believe in these young people and their potential. I’ve often said education is a vehicle to upward mobility and a way out of a cycle of generational poverty, chronic unemployment and violence. I met several of the dedicated staff members who believe in the potential of our young African Americans as well, and this school could be the model adopted by those failing MPS system schools.”
