Deputies Arrest Man for OWI-7th



Milwaukee, WI – This morning, at about 4:15 a.m., deputies responded to a disabled vehicle in traffic on I-43 northbound south of W. Layton Avenue in the Hale interchange.

The driver, Robert T. Grubiak, age 32, of Kenosha, was asleep in the driver's seat. He performed poorly on field sobriety tests, with a PBT result of .21. His driver's license had been revoked.

Grubiak had six prior convictions for Operating While Intoxicated (OWI): two in January 2010, April 2011, July 2011, August 2011 and September 2014. He told deputies he had a couple of drinks before driving. He is currently on probation/parole for OWI, and faces charges of OWI-7th, a Class F felony punishable by a mandatory three years in prison, and a misdemeanor charge of Operating While Revoked, which carries a penalty of up to 30 days in jail.
