Deputies Arrest Man for OWI-4th



Milwaukee, WI – This morning, at about 12:30 a.m., deputies stopped a vehicle for lane deviation on W. National Avenue at 102nd Street in West Allis.

The driver had a revoked driver's license, and performed poorly on field sobriety tests, with a PBT result of .12. Clinton J. Stauff, age 48, of West Allis, was arrested for OWI-4th offense. Stauff said he had been at a bar and had one drink and one beer. His prior OWI convictions were in July 1990, September 1993, and August 2009.

If convicted of this Class H felony OWI-4th offense, Stauff faces up to six years in prison. He also is being charged with Operating While Revoked, a misdemeanor punishable by up to 30 days in jail.
