Operation Drive Sober Results in 6 Arrests 1799 Repeat Offenders Since January 2010

Milwaukee, WI – Acting Sheriff Richard R. Schmidt ordered an aggressive Operating While Intoxicated (OWI- drugs and/or alcohol) initiative to rid the Milwaukee County freeway system of intoxicated drivers. This weekend's Operation Drive Sober initiative from Friday at 4:00 p.m. through today at 6:00 a.m., resulted in the arrest of six drunken drivers. The average PBT test results were .13.

Two repeat offenders were arrested: Steven Dixon, age 24, of Madison, and Willesey Haye, age 44, of Greendale, both for OWI-2nd offense. A release was sent out yesterday on Dixon's arrest after he led deputies on a high speed chase, drove the wrong way on the freeway, and fled on foot after crashing into a Waukesha County deputy's squad.

First-time offenders taken into custody were: Ryan Hanus, age 28, of Greendale, and Milwaukee residents: Marquis Berry, age 37, Gregory Wilder, age 26, and Afzal Ahmed, age 25.
