Sheriff's Award Recipient

Milwaukee County Supervisor Mark Borkowski would like to congratulate two special constituents who were recognized by Sheriff David Clarke this past year.

Correctional Officer Aron Arvelo received a Letter of Commendation along with other supporting officers for their quick thinking which helped save the life of an inmate. The subject was unresponsive, in apparent distress and having difficulty breathing.

Arvelo and two other officers repositioned the subject and assisted in providing CPR and rescue breathing. On duty nurses activated the Emergency Response System including the Automated External Defibrillator (AED), restarting his heart. The subject's survival was impacted by the quick response and professionalism of Correctional Officer Aron Arvelo his fellow officers and medical personnel.

Detective Steven J. Wolf, who is now retired, received the Sheriff's Superior Achievement Award. His 34-year law enforcement career included the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Department, the Wisconsin State

Patrol and the Brown Deer Police Department.

In the summer of 2009, Detective Wolf became aware that a suspect shot two Milwaukee Police Officers. Although the shooter was prosecuted, Detective Wolf determined that the weapon was fraudulently obtained and provided to the shooter in violation of federal gun laws. Detective Wolf was honored for commitment to his injured fellow officers in this investigation and his boundless energy to the citizens of Milwaukee County.

Milwaukee Justice Center launches Legal Self-Help Website

Every year, thousands of people receive help at the Milwaukee Justice Center (MJC), which is a public-private partnership between Milwaukee County, The Milwaukee Bar Association, and Marquette University Law School, created to assist low income, self-represented litigants and others seeking legal assistance.

Self-represented litigants have a fundamental right to access the justice system even if they cannot afford an attorney or do not qualify for legal aid. While the desire is for everyone to have attorney representation, for those who have no choice but to go it alone, the Milwaukee Justice Center is here to assist them, and the website is an important part of that.

The launch of this new website provides greater access to justice in Milwaukee County. Those who visit the website will be able to access forms and information needed to navigate the civil legal process, there are also links to community and other legal resources.

"Stockboxes" for Seniors

Today, many people are having a hard time keeping up with the cost of food. For seniors living on a fixed income, it can be even more of a challenge. If you or someone you know is single over the age of 60 and has a monthly income that does not exceed \$1,180 (or \$1,593 for two people), they could receive a free "stockbox."

Stockboxes are free, pre-packaged boxes of food delivered to low-income senior housing sites and senior centers.

To find out if you qualify, call 2-1-1. Callers will learn of the nearest Stockbox pickup location and date, as well as other assistance available.
