## 2011 Sheriff's Award Recipient

Milwaukee County Supervisor Mark Borkowski would like to congratulate two constituents who were recognized by Sheriff David Clarke this past year.

**Deputy Sheriff Karl Turek**, an 11 year veteran who serves on the Police Services Bureau's Targeted Enforcement Unit, received the Superior Achievement Award. Deputy Turek was enjoying a hot day off at a pool party in his Franklin neighborhood when another off-duty officer from the Milwaukee Police Department saw a young boy lying motionless on the bottom of the pool. Both men leaped into action and dove to recover the lifeless boy. Once on the deck, both officers performed resuscitation efforts with the help of Fire Department personnel that responded. Their immediate and decisive action, performed in a team fashion with a fellow officer, enabled this young man to live to tell this story.

On a Milwaukee summer night, 10-year veteran **Deputy Sheriff Bradley Summers** received Letters of Commendation for his response to a scene at Smith Park, in which three subjects were armed with a gun. Upon Deputy Sheriff Summers arrival, two of the suspects fled. Deputy Sheriff Summers and his fellow officers worked in tandem to interview the suspect and search the area. The officers located the pistol buried in the sand by the children's playground. The other suspects were located at the intersection of N. 33rd St. and W. Custer Ave. and were taken into custody without incident. Comprehensive investigation, follow-up and coordination are the hallmarks of professionalism.

## *Helping Homeless Veterans*

Homelessness is a serious problem in America and it is especially deplorable for our Veterans. To end homelessness, we must prevent it from happening in the first place. **StockBoxes** are the Hunger Task Force's contract with the State to operate the *Commodity Supplemental Food Program*. This program provides a box of nutritious food that is delivered to low-income seniors in Southeastern Wisconsin. 
