## **COUNTY RECEIVES \$100,000 GRANT FOR UNIVERSAL SCREENING**

*Supervisor Broderick recognized for leading the charge to fund jail screening in County Budget*

**Milwaukee, WI** – Milwaukee County Supervisor Gerry Broderick is pleased to announce that Milwaukee County has been selected to receive a \$100,000 grant from the State of Wisconsin Office of Justice Assistance to expand the Universal Screening Program.

In a letter to Supervisor Broderick, Joseph L. Volk, Chief Executive Officer of Community Advocates, congratulated Supervisor Broderick for showing the “vision and courage to do the right thing last fall,” when a key amendment to the 2011 County Budget added funding for Universal Screening in Milwaukee County.

“This \$100,000 grant is on top of the \$250,000 the County Board allocated to Universal Screening, and it’s my hope that additional dollars will be awarded to help us continue this project for Milwaukee County,” Supervisor Broderick said. “It was my pleasure to shepherd this through the budget process.”
