Supervisor Dimitrijevic Announces Grand Opening of the New South Shore Bike Trail

Free Reggae/World Music Concert to Follow Ceremony

Supervisor Dimitrijevic, along with the Milwaukee County Parks, South Shore Park Watch, and Bay View Bicycle Club will unveil the newly completed and re-constructed South Shore Bike Trail this **Thursday, June 22nd at 6:00pm at a ceremony in front of the South Shore Park Pavilion**. The completion of the second phase of this large-scale, Milwaukee County-sponsored, capital improvement project includes shoreline protection and major improvements to the previously eroded bike trail.

“This is an exciting day for our neighborhood and many generations to come will benefit from Milwaukee County’s investment in South Shore Park and our lakefront,” said Supervisor Dimitrijevic.

“The South Shore Bike Path will make a great addition to the 106-mile Oak Leaf Trail, one of the most premier bike trail systems in the nation,” said Parks Director Sue Black.

Immediately following the program will be a **Free, Reggae/World Music Concert from 6:30-8:30pm**.

“The free concert in South Shore Park marks the beginning of a summer filled with positive events in this park from the South Shore Farmer’s Market to the South Shore Frolics,” said Supervisor Dimitrijevic.

Local elected officials and many residents are expected to attend.
