PULASKI INDOOR POOL TEMPORARILY CLOSES FOR ROOF REPAIRS

Milwaukee County offers several other aquatic options for families to enjoy

Milwaukee, WI – Supervisor Marina Dimitrijevic is informing 4th District constituents of a temporary pool closure at the Pulaski Indoor Pool. The pool is suffering from several leaks that have worsened over the years. As a result, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors approved the roof repairs in the 2007 Capital Improvement Budget. Beginning August 1, the Pulaski Pool will temporarily shut down for much-needed roof repairs. The pool will reopen to the public as soon as possible. The estimated repair time is 3-6 weeks.

“While this pool closure will be a short-term inconvenience, these repairs are long overdue,” Supervisor Dimitrijevic said. “The Milwaukee County Board knows Pulaski Indoor Pool is a valuable resource for south side residents. We’re committed to maintaining this popular amenity for our County residents.”

In the meantime, residents of the 4th District can use the pools at Pelican Cove (Kosciuszko Park) or Jackson Park for recreational swimming from 11:30 a.m.-7:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday and 11:30 a.m.-6:00 p.m. on Fridays and Saturdays. Wilson Pool is available for lap swimming free of charge from 7:00 a.m.-10:00 a.m. Recreational swimming is also available from 1:30 p.m.-6:00 p.m. Water exercise classes will continue at Noyes Indoor Pool while Pulaski is closed.

In addition, all Pulaski Pool memberships will be extended for one month from the current expiration date. Memberships can also be used at other Milwaukee County pools during the temporary closure.
