**CHAIRMAN HOLLOWAY MAKES NEXT TWO APPOINTMENTS TO
MILWAUKEE COUNTY PARKS ADVISORY COMMISSION**

Attorney F. William Haberman and Penelope Stewart are latest appointments to panel

Milwaukee, WI – Milwaukee County Board Chairman Lee Holloway has made the following two appointments to the Milwaukee County Parks Advisory Commission:

- **F. William Haberman** is an attorney with the law firm Michael Best & Friedrich and is a partner in the Wealth Planning Services Group. He is also very active in the philanthropic community, serving as President of the Herzfeld Foundation and Chairman of the Public Policy Forum. Last year, Mr. Haberman was appointed to the Milwaukee Public Museum Recovery Committee.
- **Penelope Stewart** is Community Outreach Manager for the Blood Center of Wisconsin Marrow Donor Program. She is active in the community, including at the Milwaukee Urban League, New Concept Development and Milwaukee Art Museum.

“Mr. Haberman and Ms. Stewart will certainly bring a lot to the table,” Chairman Holloway added. “I look forward to seeing the results this new Commission brings forward.”

Earlier this month, Chairman Holloway appointed historian **John Gurda** and U.S. Administrative Judge **Henry Hamilton III** to the Commission. Three more Commission members will be named next month, including a Commission Chair. The appointments are subject to confirmation by the full County Board. The Parks Advisory Commission will provide policy and funding guidance to the County Board on issues such as budget, preservation and maintenance needs of the County Parks.
