**CHAIRMAN HOLLOWAY MAKES FIRST TWO APPOINTMENTS TO
MILWAUKEE COUNTY PARKS ADVISORY COMMISSION**

Historian John Gurda and Administrative Judge Henry Hamilton III

Milwaukee, WI – Milwaukee County Board Chairman Lee Holloway has made the first two appointments to the Milwaukee County Parks Advisory Commission:

- **John Gurda** is a popular and well-respected writer of the history of Milwaukee, including the Milwaukee County Parks System. Gurda frequently writes for the *Milwaukee Journal Sentinel* and is well known for his *The Making of Milwaukee* book and television documentary, which appeared on Milwaukee Public Television.
- **Henry Hamilton III** is an Administrative Judge for the U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission and was previously a Magistrate Judge for the State of Iowa. He is a long-time Parks enthusiast and has lived in Milwaukee for 28 years.

“I look forward to seeing the results this Commission brings forward,” Chairman Holloway added. “Mr. Gurda and Mr. Hamilton will certainly bring a lot to the table.”

Chairman Holloway will appoint five additional Commission members, including a Commission Chair, later this month. The appointments are subject to confirmation by the full County Board. The Parks Advisory Commission will provide policy and funding guidance to the County Board on issues such as budget, preservation and maintenance needs of the County Parks.
