RESULTS FROM TODAY'S MILWAUKEE COUNTY BOARD MEETING

- 12-7 (**veto sustained**) (No: Borkowski, Cesarz, De Bruin, Mayo, Rice, Sanfelippo, Schmitt) to override the County Executive's veto of a resolution to draft revisions to extend health benefit coverage to domestic partners of eligible Milwaukee County employees.
- 16-1 (No: Weishan) to approve an amended resolution to prepare a plan of action related to Park Maintenance Workers 2 positions.
- 18-1 (No: Weishan) to approve a contract with U.S. Bank for prepaid debit cards.
- 11-8 (No: Borkowski, Cesarz, De Bruin, Jursik, Rice, Sanfelippo, West, Holloway) **to reject** a resolution requiring that the County Board approve any contract for new housekeeping services as provided for in the 2010 Adopted Budget.
- 18-1 (No: Thomas) to approve the negotiated sale with Merrill Lynch for the Airport Revenue Bonds and Airport Revenue Refunding Bonds.
- 18-1 (No: Weishan) to adopt a resolution/ordinance to amend various sections of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances as it pertains to wage, health and pension benefits for non-represented employees.
- 15-4 (No: Clark, Johnson, Mayo, Thomas) to adopt a resolution approving A'viands, LLC Professional Service Contract for the Behavioral Health Division.
- 16-2-1 (No Cesarz, Rice; Abstain-Sanfelippo) to continue to retain O'Neil, Cannon, Hollman, DeJong, S.C. to represent the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors in connection with *Milwaukee District Council 48 v. Milwaukee County et al.*, and pay the reasonable and necessary fees for that representation.
- 14-5 (No: Broderick, Clark, Dimitrijevic, Weishan, Holloway) to approve a resolution modifying the requirements for the position of Director, Department of Transportation and Public Works, by making a Professional Engineer (PE) degree a preferred, rather than mandatory, requirement for appointment.
- 16-1 (No: Sanfelippo; Excused: De Bruin, Mayo) to grant a conservation easement at the House of Correction, 8885 S. 68th Street, Franklin, Wisconsin to the City of Franklin.
- 16-1 (No: Lipscomb; Excused: De Bruin, Mayo) to adopt a substitute resolution approving the habitat restoration landscaping plan for the County Grounds/UW Milwaukee development.
- 8-9 (**motion fails**) (No: Cesarz, Clark, Jursik, Rice, Sanfelippo, Schmitt, Thomas, West, Holloway) to approve a resolution to officially rescind the employee furlough days on December 4 and December 24, 2009. (item not necessary, as December furlough dates were rescinded by County Board Chairman, Finance & Audit Committee Chair and County Executive earlier this month)
