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### RESULTS FROM TODAY'S MILWAUKEE COUNTY BOARD MEETING

- 9-9 (motion to approve fails) (No: Borkowski, Cesarz, Clark, Coggs, Mayo, Rice, Schmitt, Weishan, Holloway) to use \$2 million of the proceeds from the sale of a portion of the northeast quadrant of the County Grounds to the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee to address parks deferred maintenance needs. **(Supervisor Larson served notice for reconsideration of this item at the next County Board meeting)**
- 11-8 (No: Borkowski, Cesarz, Jursik, Larson, Lipscomb, Rice, Sanfelippo, Schmitt) to override **(veto sustained)** the County Executive's veto of a resolution to support modifying state judicial districts to achieve better ethnic diversity of elected circuit court judges.
- 17-2 (No: Broderick, Schmitt) to approve an amended resolution to apply for funding from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources for repair of the Estabrook Dam.
- 14-5 (No: Cesarz, De Bruin, Rice, Sanfelippo, Schmitt) to refer back to the Judiciary, Safety & General Services Committee a resolution seeking legislation to amend Wisconsin Statutes to remove the requirement to elect a county executive in counties with a population of 500,000 or more and allow the appointment of a county administrator.
- 14-5 (No: Clark, Coggs, Lipscomb, West, Holloway) to amend the current parking lot lease agreement with Van Buren Management, Inc., with terms as described in the report and settlement of a pending lawsuit.
- 14-5 (No: Clark, Coggs, Sanfelippo, Thomas, West) to submit the annual DBE goals for USDOT assisted projects, to both the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and Federal Transit Administration (FTA) for anticipated contracts in Federal Fiscal Year 2010.
- 13-6 (No: Clark, Coggs, Dimitrijevic, Jursik, Lipscomb, West) to amend Airport Agreements with Host International, Inc., and SSP America, Inc., to reduce airport employee discounts from 20% to 10%.
- 18-0 to approve most of the 2010 Community Development Block Grant funds (contact Public Information Division for roll calls on specific items).
- 14-4 (No: Borkowski, Cesarz, Rice, Sanfelippo) to ratify the Memorandum of Agreement between Milwaukee County and the Association of Milwaukee County Attorneys.
- 14-4 (No: Borkowski, Cesarz, Rice, Sanfelippo) to ratify the Memorandum of Agreement between Milwaukee County and the Technicians, Engineers, and Architects of Milwaukee County.
- 8-10 (Yes: Borkowski, Cesarz, Jursik, Rice, Sanfelippo, Schmitt, Thomas, Holloway) **to lay over (motion to lay over approved on minority rules)** the Memorandum of Agreement between Milwaukee County and Milwaukee County District Council 48, AFSCME, AFL-CIO and its appropriate locals.

- 6-12 (Yes: Borkowski, Cesarz, Larson, Rice, Sanfelippo, West) to remove from Committee **(Motion to remove from Committee for consideration at full County Board failed)** a resolution urging the State of Wisconsin to amend the State Statutes to require members of the Milwaukee Area Technical College Board of Directors be elected directly by voters who reside in the territory of the district. .
