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### RESULTS FROM TODAY'S MILWAUKEE COUNTY BOARD MEETING

- 10-8 (No: Borkowski, Cesarz, De Bruin, Lipscomb, Mayo, Rice, Sanfelippo, Schmitt) to override **(veto sustained)** the County Executive's veto of a resolution authorizing the Chief Judge of Milwaukee County to collaborate with the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee to develop Shakespeare in the Courts as a pilot alternative to incarceration option for sentencing of juvenile offenders.
- 16-2 (No: Harris, Mayo) to appoint Kerry Mitchell to the position of Director of the Division of Human Resources, Department of Administrative Services for Milwaukee County.
- 16-2 (No: Sanfelippo, Holloway) to approve a resolution broadening the scope of a previously approved audit of the Office of the Sheriff to assess the impact of alternative to incarceration programs on jail bed occupancy and the use of the Federal Forfeiture revenues to enhance law enforcement services in Milwaukee County.
- 15-3 (No: Cesarz, Rice, Sanfelippo) to approve a substitute resolution to amend County Ordinances as it pertains to sick leave policies regarding sick allowance accrual and payout or credit at retirement.
- 18-0 to refer to the **Finance & Audit Committee and the Parks, Energy & Environment Committee** a requested fund transfer to reallocate \$213,000 of funds from Public Art Money to Zablocki Park Baseball Fields Restoration.
- 12-6 (No: Borkowski, Cesarz, Johnson, Rice, Sanfelippo, Weishan) to approve a resolution authorizing and directing the Director of the Department of Health and Human Services to enroll Milwaukee County in the National Association of Counties modified prescription drug discount card program.
- 12-6 (No: Borkowski, Cesarz, Johnson, Mayo, Rice, Sanfelippo) to approve a resolution regarding the temporary restraining order against the Office of the Sheriff by Milwaukee County.
- 11-7 (Borkowski, Cesarz, De Bruin, Rice, Sanfelippo, Schmitt, Holloway) to prohibit the Sheriff from creating a monthly Huber Parking Fee of \$25 at the County Correctional Facility-South.
- 15-3 (No: Cesarz, Rice, Sanfelippo) to refer back to the Judiciary, Safety & General Services Committee a request from the Office of the Sheriff requesting authorization to enter into a contract with Century Link Correctional Communication Service for inmate phone service at the County Correctional Facilities.
- 17-1 (No: Rice) to approve a resolution opposing the proposed construction of an electric transmission line along Underwood Creek Parkway (Route B), to the Milwaukee County Grounds to connect to the Power Plant at 93<sup>rd</sup> Street and Watertown Plank Road, as part of the Western Milwaukee County Electric Reliability Project proposed by We Energies and the American Transmission Company (ATC).
- **No objection to refer back to the Transportation, Public Works and Transit Committee** a request to enter into a lease agreement with the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Department, effective February 1, 2012, for the lease of approximately 7,676 square feet of vehicle maintenance shop space

(Building 104) and approximately twenty (20) paved parking spaced at Milwaukee County's MKE Regional Business Park (the former 440<sup>th</sup> Air Force Reserve Station).

- **No objection to refer back to the Transportation, Public Works and Transit Committee** a request to enter into a lease agreement with the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Department, effective February 1, 2012, for the lease of approximately 1,670 square feet of truck inspection facility space (Building 204) and approximately twenty (20) paved parking spaced at Milwaukee County's MKE Regional Business Park (the former 440<sup>th</sup> Air Force Reserve Station).
- 18-0 to sell County-owned Park East Corridor lands located in the City of Milwaukee to the Milwaukee School of Engineering.
- 15-3 (No: Cesarz, Rice, Sanfelippo) to approve a substitute resolution to clarify and extend, on an emergency and non-precedential basis, employee compensation and benefits policies to employees formerly represented by District Council 48 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, in order to avoid administrative confusion and uncertainty, until the County Board adopts applicable policies.
