HIGHLIGHTS OF RESULTS FROM MILWAUKEE COUNTY BOARD MEETING: APRIL 24, 2014

- 14-4 (No: Alexander, Borkowski, Staskunas, Taylor) requesting authorization to transfer \$78,374 from the Contingency Fund to provide funding for three positions and computer equipment necessary to comply with enforcement duties relative to the living wage ordinance. (Item 23)
- 17-1 (No: Lipscomb) requesting authorization to transfer approximately 1.7 acres of land that is a remnant of the former Underwood Creek parkway and use proceeds from the land transfer to finance Veterans Park Pavilion and Restroom and flood related projects. (Item 31)
- 15-3 (No: Alexander, Borkowski, Taylor) to abolish one vacant position of Administrative Secretary 2-Constituent Services Representative (Item 37)
- 16-2 (No: Jursik, Weishan) requesting authorization to amend Chapter 16 of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances as it pertains to Care Management Governing Board (Item 43)
- 13-5 (No: Alexander, Borkowski, Lipscomb, Schmitt, Taylor) providing for an advisory referendum on the November 4, 2014 election ballot on whether the United States Constitution should be amended to establish that only human beings, not corporations, are entitled to constitutional rights (Item 48)
- 12-6 (No: Broderick, Cullen, Johnson, Rainey, Romo West, Weishan) to refer back to committee a resolution providing for an advisory referendum on the November 4, 2014, election ballot on whether tax revenue should be used to help pay for the renovation or construction of a new sports and entertainment arena (Item 49)
- 11-7 (No: Alexander, Borkowski, Cullen, Jursik, Schmitt, Staskunas, Taylor) on passage of a resolution supporting recovery and release of public records related to Milwaukee County business activity which is subject to the Wisconsin Open Records Law (Item 50)

- 16-2 (No: Borkowski, Taylor) a resolution expanding the criteria for the existing Free Birth Certificate Program to include individuals between the ages of 15 to 21 years old who are in need of birth certificates to assist in securing employment opportunities (Item 51)
- 12-6 (No: Alexander, Borkowski, Jursik, Schmitt, Staskunas, Taylor) a resolution/ordinance expanding and defining Milwaukee County's non-discrimination policy to ensure equal opportunity for all persons
- 16-2 (No: Borkowski, Taylor) to develop a Voter Registration Program to allow Milwaukee County residents to register to vote at locations where they apply for, renew, or update information for the receipt of social services (Item 53)
- 16-2 (No: Borkowski, Mayo) requesting approval of an intergovernmental agreement and Memorandum of Understanding with the City of Wauwatosa Community Development Authority that transfers an environmentally-impaired foreclosed property (Item 75)
